## EQUITY

### EQUITY WORKGROUP UPDATE

- **Equity Mini Grant:** Our PN-3 Coalition has been granted an Equity Mini Grant from Pritzker to deepen family leadership and engagement. More soon on this exciting development!



## MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH

### DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH UPDATE

- **CARA Plans of Care** - CYFD + DOH hiring social worker (external to DOH and CYFD) to support follow up services (to better understand if family accepted plan of care, how it's going and whether they need additional resources for support).
- **Maternal Depression Screening** - Looking at ways to understand maternal depression and barriers to screening + referrals. Working on a health provider survey - to understand where practices are w/ screenings + referrals in different communities.
- **NM Maternal Mortality Review Committee** - SB96 passed in Legislature - DOH introduced bill to correct issues from 2019 bill which addresses restrictions around reimbursement, and makes membership more diverse.
- **12 months postpartum Medicaid Coverage** - New Mexico is looking at the health coverage implications in the federal stimulus package, and how it can incentivize expansion of postpartum medicaid coverage to 12 months.



## HOME VISITING

### ECECD UPDATE

#### Home Visiting Medicaid Expansion

- 3 project teams met for 3 months - on how state would appropriate and use state funded dollars to support programs, expanding for Centennial Home Visiting.
- Looked at recommendations for expanding Centennial 2.0 Waiver; support for programs and operations; relationships with Managed Care Organizations (MCO) partners; support network for onboarding new programs; better alignment (centralized billing, centralized referral and data system that connects to programs in place)
- In process of finalizing plan, to be shared in May.
